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DIVING

The crew of Quino el Guardian is here to help you in any way possible to make your visit to the Socorro Islands an unforgettable experience.

The Sea of Cortez, also known as the Gulf of California is a strip of water separated from the Pacific Ocean by the Baja Peninsula. This isolation, on land and underwater, provides a unique series of contrasting ecosystems from the vast solitude of the desert to the rich underwater realms and black coral gardens.

This is a unique opportunity aboard Quino el Guardian where we will be at the right place at the right time to see blue whales, bull sharks, and flying mobula rays. Go on day and night dives at remote islands, encountering the abundant sea life of the southern Sea of Cortez. We will also explore popular dive sites such as Los Islotes where you will encounter friendly sea lions and El Bajo known for its schools of hammerhead sharks. We will also spend a day diving in Cabo Pulmo National Marine Park, the only living reef on this side of the hemisphere where divers can experience schools of fish that are over 40' tall.

Our trips have three divemasters on board to lead dives and assist divers. We also have two zodiac drivers vigilantly watching for bubbles and retrieving divers upon surfacing. We provide 80 cubic ft. aluminum tanks that are both DIN & yoke compatible.

ABOUT THE BOAT

Quino el Guardian is of the utmost seaworthiness and is approved by both the U.S. Coast Guard and the Mexican Coast Guard. It is equipped with state of the art electronics and all safety equipment required.

Quino el Guardian is 90' long with a 23' beam.

The number of guests Quino el Guardian accommodates is 16.

There are four air-conditioned cabins that sleep four guests each. There are two bunks on each side. Each bunk has a privacy curtain. Each cabin is outfitted with four large drawers, one for each guest. There is also storage space under the bottom bunks and clothing/towel hooks in the main cabin area. Cabins are typically assigned by gender.

There is one cabin with 2 bunks that sleeps 2. This cabin is generally reserved for a couple.

Our guests enjoy Tempur-Pedic® mattresses and quality bed linens. Our steward cleans all rooms, bunks, and bathrooms during the first dives of the day. We provide bath towels and dive deck towels and these are changed mid-trip.



Quino has four, air-conditioned bathrooms with a full-size shower in each bathroom on the dive deck. Each cabin is assigned to a bathroom so guests can leave their personal items and towels in the bathroom. Shampoo and soap dispensers are in each shower. There are two lavatories on the dive deck that are shared by all passengers.

The galley comfortably accommodates all 16 passengers. The galley also has a projector and a large drop-down screen should your group want to do presentations.

The comfortable salon has sofas, a TV, and a computer table.

The dive deck is large and well organized with a spacious camera table. There is a dive platform for ease of boarding the inflatables. Quino has two 18' Achilles inflatables for the safety and ease of our divers with very sturdy ladders.

On the second deck, there is a large shaded sundeck with lawn chairs for relaxing between dives.

All voltage aboard Quino el Guardian is 110 just like the USA.

PASSENGER INFORMATION & LIABILITY RELEASE FORMS

Prior to your trip date, we require passenger registration information for every guest. This is completed on-line:

To make this process as easy as possible, gather all pertinent information such as dive certifications, medical and dive insurance information, etc. before you start. Read the instructions provided at the beginning of the form. Once you start, you will have a 4-hour window to complete the form otherwise you will need to restart the process.

The more information we have about you, the better we can accommodate your needs including dietary restrictions if any.

In addition, we require a manually-signed liability waiver. You will find a link to this form when you complete your online passenger information.

Once you manually sign the liability waivers, this needs to be sent to Janet in Guest Services along with a photograph of your passport. Please send your manually-signed liability release form and photograph of your passport to:

CONTACT INFORMATION

Quino el Guardian maintains daily contact with our US office via radio communications. We are ready for constant communication in the event of an emergency. Your family and friends are welcome to contact our office at (602)558-9580 in case of an emergency. Our office staff will immediately assist your family and friends in getting messages to you. We also have a satellite phone onboard for your use and emergency needs. The phone number is 011 881 6326 54109 and the rate for using the phone is \$2 per minute.

We do not have Wi-Fi on the boat.

GETTING TO THE BOAT

Quino el Guardian is located at Marina Puerto Los Cabos in San Jose del Cabo. All guests must travel to San Jose del Cabo (SJD). Guests are responsible for their own transportation to and from the boat. The marina is about 25 minutes from the airport.

After you collect your bags and leave customs, you will enter a lobby.

Go to the taxi stand.

There are two recommended ways to get from the airport to the marina:

TAXI

You can take a taxi directly from the airport to the marina. The cost is approximately \$60 US.

COLLECTIVO (SHUTTLE) & A TAXI

This is the most economical way to get from the airport to the marina.

At the taxi stand, ask for a colectivo. A colectivo is a very nice shuttle that takes about 9 passengers and drops people at the hotels. This costs approximately \$15 US. Since you're going to San Jose you will be dropped off first. You can have the colectivo drop you off at the Tropicana Inn. Once at the Tropicana Inn, they can request

a taxi to Marina Los Cabos. You shouldn't pay more than \$15 US. It's about a 15-minute ride from the hotel to the marina.

By choosing the colectivo & taxi method, you can expect to pay about \$30 US.

If you arrive early (boarding begins at 5 pm), you can store your luggage at the Tropicana Inn for \$7 per person. The hotel is centrally located and there are plenty of shops and restaurants in the area.

The Tropicana Inn can arrange for group transportation to the marina for up to 5 persons for \$25. This arrangement must be made in advance and can be done so at reserve@tropicainnloscabos.com.

[DIRECTIONS TO QUINO EL GUARDIAN FROM THE AIRPORT AND DOWNTOWN SAN JOSE DEL CABO](#)

Marina Puerto Los Cabos is about a 25-minute taxi ride from the airport and 15 minutes from downtown San Jose del Cabo. Please drive toward the small fishing town of "La Playita" and El Ganzo Hotel. Once you are in the marina area you will be driving on a long, winding road with roundabouts. To your right, you will see a tall, beige building called MARINE GROUP and on the other corner an OXXO store. Turn right at the Marine Group building and OXXO store. Keep driving toward El Ganzo Hotel. Quino el Guardian is docked about 100 yards before El Ganzo hotel. There is a small, adobe colored building with several parking spaces. This is the entrance to the dock.

RETURN

The boat will return to the marina during the night and passengers need to be ready to depart by 8:30 am on the last day of your trip. A continental breakfast will be served. Our crew will call taxis to get everyone to the airport or their hotel.

SUGGESTED GEAR & CLOTHING

Besides your normal dive gear, every diver is required to have the following: dive computer, safety sausage (SMB) and a whistle.

Every diver is required to have a dive computer, safety sausage (SMB) and a whistle.

We absolutely recommend exposure protection (wetsuits/light drysuits) on our trips. Water temperatures range from 78°-82°F (26°-28°C) depending on the time of year.

The dress is casual. Bring a light jacket. Do not forget your hat, sunglasses, and sunscreen.

RENTAL DIVE EQUIPMENT

We have a limited number of regulators, BCD's, dive computers and HP steel 100cft/12L steel tanks available for rental at \$50 each, per trip. Please let us know at least 3 weeks prior to your arrival if you want to rent equipment so we have it onboard for you. We do not rent exposure suits, hood, fins, masks, safety sausages (SMB's), whistles or lights. As we have a limited number of these items available to rent, they are available on a first-come, first-served basis. WHAT IS INCLUDED IN THE PRICE OF THE TRIP

The price of your trip INCLUDES:

- 🔗 Crew Gratuity (10%-15% of the trip price is customary)

Fees and gratuity can be paid in advance or on the boat. Cash (USD, Pesos, and Euros) and MasterCard/Visa are accepted.

****Fuel Surcharge:** Rocio del Mar has the right to implement a fuel surcharge on all trips in the event the cost of fuel surpasses 20 Pesos per liter. Should this occur, all guests will be notified prior to boarding.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Proof of diving certification and dive insurance is required. Without proof, you will not be able to dive.
NO EXCEPTIONS!

Quino el Guardian reserves the right to assign all cabins.

All guests are required to have dive insurance. Dive insurance can be purchased at www.DiversAlertNetwork.org. If you have private health insurance coverage for dive accidents, provide **only** the page that states coverage for a scuba diving accident, evacuation, and the declaration page showing you are the owner of the policy and policy number.

We recommend you purchase trip insurance.

The crossing from San Jose del Cabo to the Socorro Islands takes approximately 26-28 hours. It is open sea, therefore, please be prepared in case we are faced with rough seas. There are several over-the-counter remedies that can help you. In case you have a propensity to motion sickness or are concerned that you might develop symptoms, please prepare yourself with preventive measures before departure.

UNFORESEEN EVENTS / TRIP INSURANCE / TRIP INTERRUPTION

Quino el Guardian Liveaboard is of the utmost seaworthiness and is approved by the U.S. Coast Guard and Mexican Coast Guard. Quino el Guardian is equipped with state-of-the-art electronics and all required safety equipment.

Passenger safety is paramount and therefore the captain has the sole discretion to change, delay, return early or cancel the cruise if necessary. These reasons include but are not limited to bad weather, perils of the sea, acts of God, political incidents or force majeure.

Trip insurance is suggested as it provides you with reimbursement for unused, non-refundable, pre-paid trip costs if you are prevented from taking your trip due to a covered reason. All trip insurance is not the same so it is important to make sure that you purchase travel insurance that includes travel interruption.

DEPOSITS & CANCELLATIONS / INDIVIDUALS

DEPOSITS

- ↪ 25% deposit is due to hold the reservation
- ↪ 25% is due six months prior to the scheduled trip date
- ↪ The remaining balance is due three months prior to the scheduled trip date

CANCELLATIONS

- ↪ There is no penalty for cancellations made 9 months or more prior to the scheduled trip date
- ↪ 25% of the full rate will be forfeited for cancellations made 91 days to 9 months prior to the scheduled trip date
- ↪ 50% of the full rate will be forfeited for cancellations made 61 to 90 days prior to the scheduled trip date
- ↪ No refunds for cancellations made 60 days prior or less to the scheduled trip date

DEPOSITS & CANCELLATIONS / GROUPS

DEPOSITS

- ↪ A \$5,000 non-refundable deposit is due to hold the reservation
- ↪ 25% of the trip price is due one year prior to the scheduled trip date (the \$5000 deposit can be used to make up the 25% deposit)
- ↪ 25% is due six months prior to the scheduled trip date
- ↪ The balance less your commission is due three months prior to the scheduled trip date

CANCELLATIONS

- ↪ There is no penalty for cancellations made 12 months or more prior to the scheduled trip date however the \$5000 deposit is non-refundable
- ↪ 25% of the full rate will be forfeited for cancellations made 12 months to six months prior to the scheduled trip date
- ↪ 50% of the full rate will be forfeited for cancellations made six months to 91 days prior to the scheduled trip date
- ↪ No refunds for cancellations made 90 days or less prior to the scheduled trip date
